Thumbing through an advance copy for this book we found that we were able to identify some new and exciting additions – such as new frogs and dragonflies - that will surely please even the most particular folk out there who enjoy hunting these animals down in their natural habitats. When you purchase this book, you will not only be able to identify our newest additions but also discover the unique sections which are sure to make this a complete guide for those seeking more specific information on each of the animals. This third edition includes an introduction from our Editor, as well as a new section covering South American frogs and how they may be confused with those from tropical regions. We begin with a main list of the reptiles and amphibians that can be found in South America, then go into detail on each of these species - going into color on some, and going into many different methods for identifying them. In the hunting section we also take a look at the importance of both native and introduced species – covering both areas where you can be successful as well as the areas to avoid. In addition, we have added a new section on insects – many people make this mistake and start hunting for snakes, only to find themselves cut short by whatever kind of insect they happen to be chasing after. This book will enable anyone to become an expert in identifying these animals much earlier than they would otherwise be able to do so. We continue with a detailed guide on which animals might be found in certain regions and even take a deeper look at some of the common land-locked species that may or may not live in your area. We have also added a section on how to take care of your catch – the best kind of information that you can ever hope to find in any hunting or fishing guide. We go into detail about proper hunting methods, as well as the best type of bait to use with each animal. We have also added a number of different pages dedicated exclusively to marsh frogs and how they are uniquely endowed by their natural habitats. At the end of the book, we include our newly expanded frog identification list for this third edition along with an entire new section dedicated specifically to amphibians covering South America. This section includes all kinds of frogs, snakes, lizards and anything else that may be found in this region. Our present state of knowledge is still far from complete and we often receive new discoveries on a fairly regular basis. We will do our best to publicize these new discoveries and add them to our list of creatures that we can add to this book in the future.
